

School Kashrut Policy

- ★ The Sandra E. Lerner Jewish Community Day School is a kosher facility. Our kitchens are dairy only.
- ★ Please do not bring meat or meat products into the school at any time (beef, veal, pork, chicken, duck, etc.).
- ★ Kosher Fish such as tuna, salmon, flounder, sole, etc. are fine to bring.
- ★ Because we observe Jewish laws of Kashrut, we also prohibit shellfish of any kind (crab, shrimp, lobster, etc.).
- ★ Any food that The Lerner School gives to the children will be kosher. Packaged foods will have Rabbinical certification on them.
- ★ Sharing of lunches is not allowed, for both Kashrut and allergy concerns.
